

Ryan makes the rounds

County Executive intends to visit and listen to every town in county

KINGSTON, N.Y. » In the 10 weeks that Ulster County Executive Pat Ryan has been in office, he has

held "town hall" meetings in eight of the county's 24 towns, outlining his vision for the county and listening to the concerns of area residents. He said he intends to visit the

remaining 14 towns before the November election.

Of the issues foremost on residents' minds to date, he said, is the opioid epidemic that seems to have the nation in its grips.

"That's something I've heard every single place I went," Ryan said in a phone interview Thursday. "In the town of Rochester in particular, where there were between 30 and 40 people, that topic just kept coming up."
"The feeling is this is something we've got to do better on,"

Ryan said.
Ryan made combating opioid addiction a key plank in his campaign platform. In July, he announced an aggressive effort to reduce opioid fatalities in the county by 50 percent over the next two years.
