#### 37.0 PRICE REVISIONS - ESCALATION / DE-ESCALATION

The "adder" offered by the Awarded vendor shall be firm and constant for the entire contract period. The actual price of the fuel will be determined by combining this adder with the current posted index as published in the *OPIS Oil Price Daily* (for all products except Propane) in accordance with the procedure described below.

## Kerosene, No. 2 Fuel Oil and Ultra Low Sulfur Diesel Fuel

The <u>Low Price</u> of the <u>"Newburgh, NY" Rack Price</u> posted in the <u>OPIS Oil Price Daily</u> postings will be used to compute <u>weekly</u> fuel prices during the contract period for Kerosene, No. 2 Fuel Oil and Ultra Low Sulfur Diesel Fuel.

The intent of this bid is to establish a price for the purchase of regular <u>ULS diesel</u> and <u>ULSD Premium diesel (#2PD)</u>. The price per gallon for both products will be indexed to the posted <u>Low Price</u> of the <u>"Newburgh, NY Rack Price"</u> for <u>regular</u> ULS Diesel. <u>Vendors will invoice Premium Diesel at the adder they offer for that product combined with the <u>appropriate Index price for regular</u> ULS Diesel.</u>

The weekly cost of the appropriate product will be determined from the prices posted on <a href="Thursday">Thursday</a> of each week. The Awarded "adder" will be combined with the posted <a href="Low Price">Low Price</a> of the "Newburgh, NY Rack Price" to determine the fuel cost for the following Friday through Thursday. Each Thursday the Awarded vendor will submit, to requesting users, the appropriate OPIS posting along with a form on their letterhead showing the index price and calculation used to establish prices for fuel delivered during the following seven days. <a href="A sample">A sample</a> form is attached that shows the information that is reguired.

The aforementioned calculation will be applied to determine fuel prices throughout the contract period. Price revisions will be rounded at four (4) decimal places. Applicable price changes will be effective as of the start of business on the following day, Friday. If the prices are not posted on Thursday, the previous business day on which the specified prices are posted will be utilized. If there is a problem of availability of prices from the Oil Price Daily, this should be brought to the attention to the Director of Purchasing and the issue will be resolved at that time.

## Gasoline, Conventional

The cost of Conventional Ethanol Gasoline will be based on the <u>average of the "Posted Rack" price for **Unbranded** Ethanol Gasoline for Albany. NY as shown in the *OPIS Oil Price Daily* postings.</u>

The weekly cost of the appropriate product will be determined from the prices posted on <a href="Thursday">Thursday</a> of each week. The Awarded "adder" will be combined with the <a href="average of the "Posted Rack" price for Unbranded Ethanol Gasoline for Albany, NY to determine the fuel cost for the following Friday through Thursday Each Thursday the Awarded vendor will submit, to requesting users, the appropriate <a href="OPIS Oil Price Daily">OPIS Oil Price Daily</a> posting along with a form on their letterhead showing the index price and calculation used to

establish prices for gasoline delivered during the following seven days. <u>A sample</u> form is attached that shows the information that is required.

The aforementioned calculation will be applied to determine fuel prices throughout the contract period. Price revisions will be rounded at four (4) decimal places. Applicable price changes will be effective as of the start of business on the following day, Friday. If the prices are not posted on Thursday, the previous business day on which the specified prices are posted will be utilized. If there is a problem of availability of prices from the Oil Price Daily, this should be brought to the attention to the Director of Purchasing and the issue will be resolved at that time.

#### LP ProQane

Price adjustments for Propane are based on the <u>BPN Weekly Propane Newsletter</u> Average Price at the <u>Selkirk rack</u> as found in their publication dated each Monday. The Awarded "adder" will be combined with the price posted in the Monday publication to determine the price for the week beginning the previous Saturday through the following Friday. If there is a problem of availability of prices from the BPN, or the specified Terminal is not available for deliveries, this should be brought to the attention to the Director of Purchasing and the issue will be resolved at that time.

The aforementioned calculation will be applied to determine propane prices throughout the contract period. Price revisions will be rounded at four (4) decimal places. The successful bidder will notify the proper agencies as to escalation or de-escalation of Propane prices ON A WEEKLY BASIS, effective Saturday through Friday. This Notice shall combine the Selkirk Average number published on Monday with the "adder" Awarded to the vendor and indicate the new cost per gallon for deliveries to the end user made during the designated week.
