- **Residential Rehab Programs**: Two programs for low income eligible homeowners in HUD designated neighborhoods. One program provides a total grant of up to \$15,000 for interior housing rehabilitation work. The other is a 50-50 loan-grant of up to \$15,000 for exterior housing rehabilitation work. The loan portion of this program is interest free and payments may be spread out over a 10 year period.
- **RESTORE HandiMan Program** Qualified homeowners receive \$500 materials and 3 days free labor to complete small renovation projects.

NYS Affordable Housing Corporation- The AHC provides financial assistance as part of a package of other private and public investment for the construction, acquisition, rehabilitation, and improvement of owner-occupied housing.
